Dr. Roland Folz has been CEO of Solarisbank AG in Berlin since February 2017. Since starting his career in 1990, he has held leading positions and been a board member in the banking environment, at HypoVereinsbank AG Group, Direkt Anlage Bank AG and Mercedes Benz Bank AG, for example. In various functions, he was responsible for the strategic development as well as the digitalisation and transformation processes of these institutions. In 2009, Dr. Folz moved to Deutsche Bank, where he was responsible for the global Private- and Business Customer division, the EMEA region and finally for the bank's global procurement and global cost management. Prior to that, he was responsible as a member of the divisional board of Deutsche Telekom, among other responsibilities, for the Deutsche Telekom technical service business.

Dr. Folz studied business mathematics in Ulm and holds an MBA from the University of Illinois, Chicago. In 1994, he acquired a doctoral degree (Dr. rer. pol.) from the University of Ulm.
